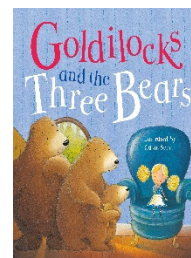
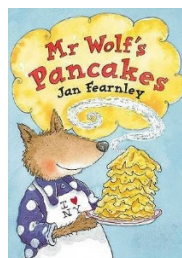
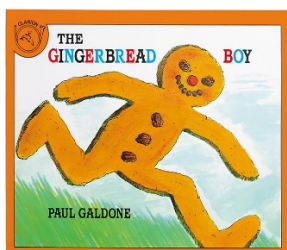

Nibbles the Book Monster

If I could nibble myself into a book it would be,



you need:

- two 1–6 dice
- counters in two colours

Add and count for 2 players

When it's your turn

Roll both dice and say the numbers.

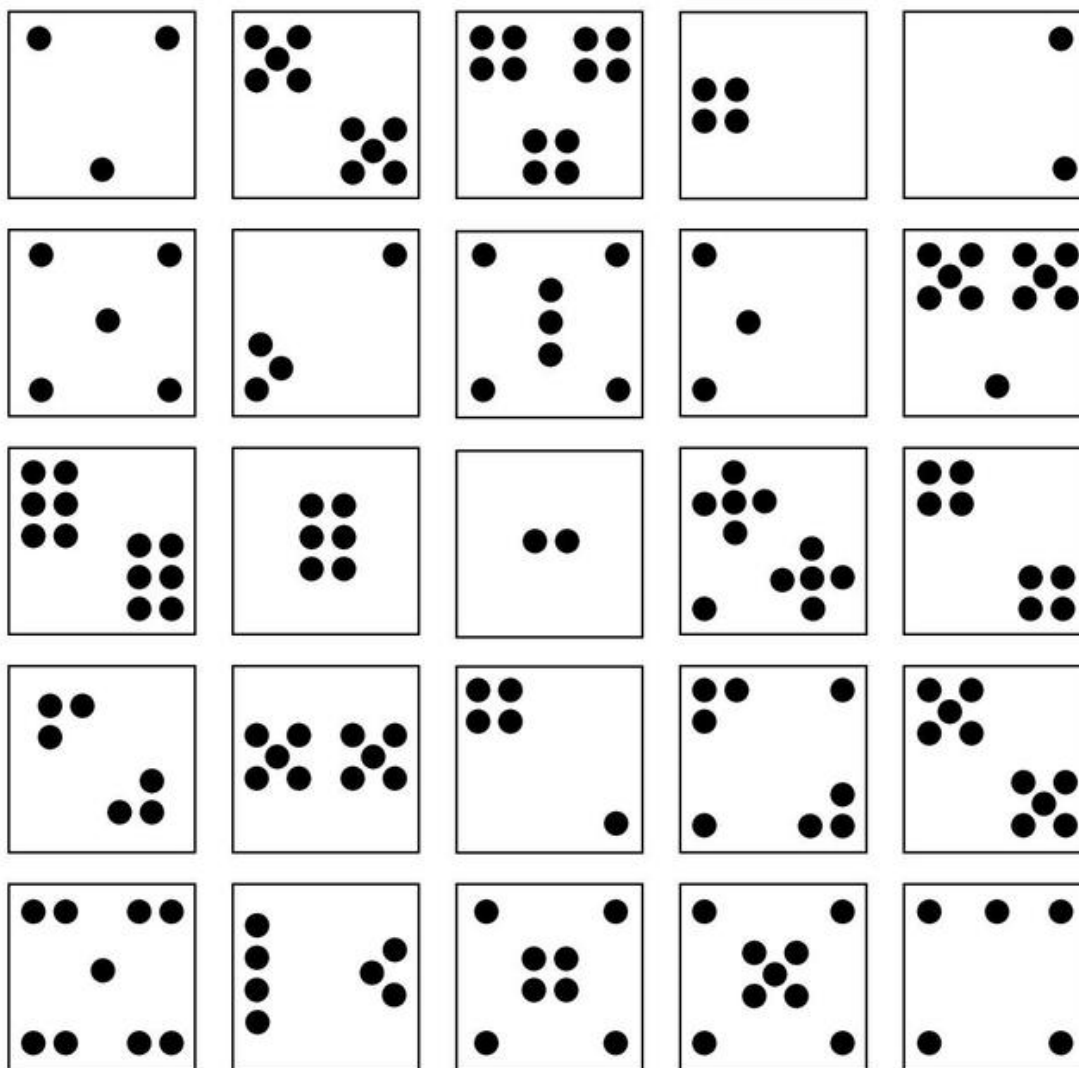
Choose ONE of the numbers, or add them together and say the answer.

Find a square with that many spots.
Put a counter there.

The rest of the game

The winner is the first player to get three of their counters in a straight line.

The line can go sideways, or up-and-down or diagonally.



you need:

- blue and red counters
- two 1–6 dice

Add or not

for 2 players

First of all

One of you, take the red counters;
the other player, take the blue counters.

When it's your turn

Roll both dice.

You can

- choose one of the numbers **or**
- add both numbers together.

Put a counter on your chosen number.
If you can't go because all the numbers
are covered, you miss your turn.

The end of the game

When one player has covered a line
of four numbers, the game is over.

(A line can go sideways, up and down
or diagonally.)

- counters in two colours (15 of each)

Totally ten snake for 2 players

First of all

Decide who has which colour counter.

When it's your turn

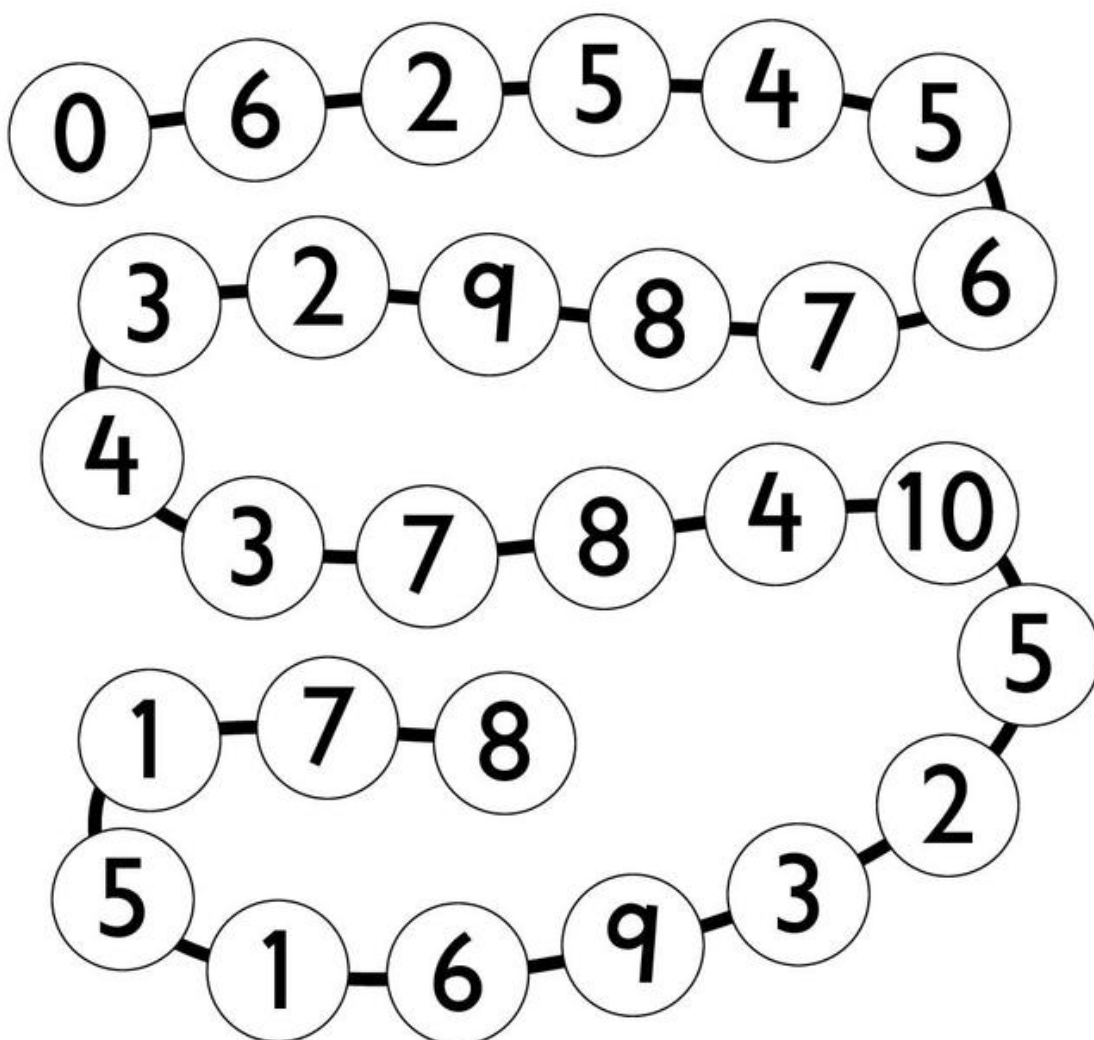
Choose two numbers which total 10.

Put a counter on each number.

The rest of the game

Go on until every number is covered.

Who has made the longest line of counters in their colour? They win.

- 1 deck of cards, numbers only (1-10)



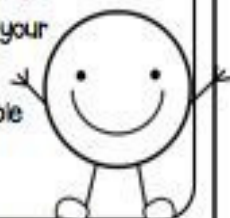
- 24 bear counters



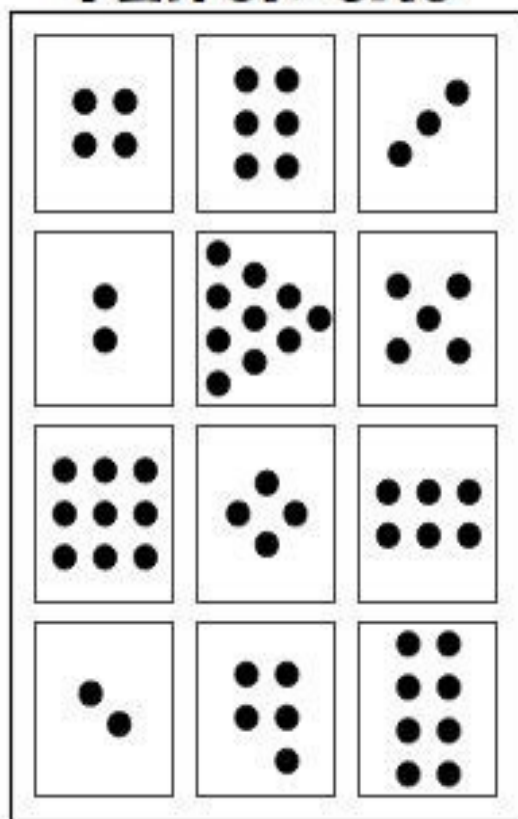
Each player

Directions

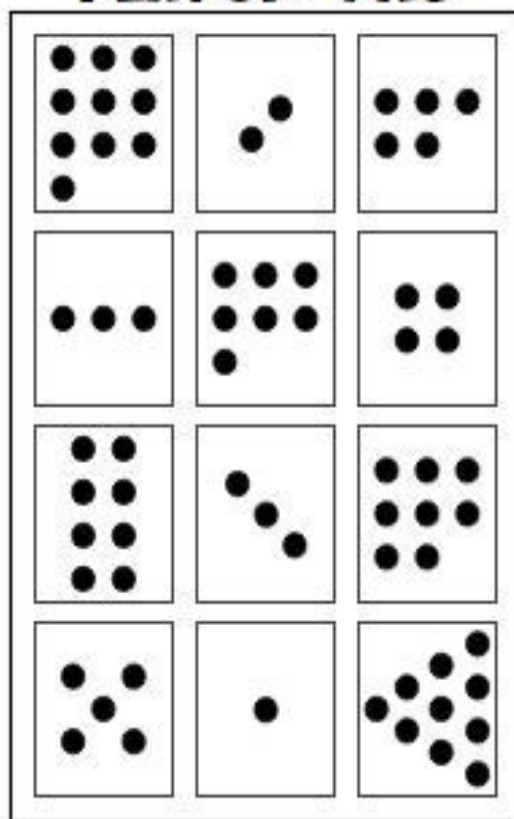
- Mix up the number cards. Put the pile of cards face down.

- Player 2: Check your partner's answer. Now it is your turn.
- Keep playing until one player has covered their whole board.





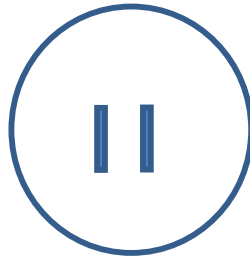
