








### Nibbles the Book Monster

#### you need:

- two I-6 dice
- · counters in two colours

## Add and count for 2 players

#### When it's your turn

Roll both dice and say the numbers.


Choose ONE of the numbers, or add them together and say the answer.

Find a square with that many spots.

#### The rest of the game

The winner is the first player to get three of their counters in a straight line.

The line can go sideways, or up-and-down or diagonally.



#### you need:

- · blue and red counters
- · two I-6 dice

## Add or not for 2 players

#### First of all

One of you, take the red counters; the other player, take the blue counters.

#### When it's your turn

Roll both dice.

You can

- · choose one of the numbers or
- · add both numbers together.

Put a counter on your chosen number. If you can't go because all the numbers are covered, you miss your turn.

#### The end of the game

When one player has covered a line of four numbers, the game is over.

(A line can go sideways, up and down or diagonally.)

#### When it's your turn


Choose two numbers which total 10.

24 bear counters




Each player needs 12 of their own color.


#### Directions
